Dear Parishioners

The 2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time, which we celebrated last week, comes after the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord, and liturgically ends the Season of Christmas. We are now in Ordinary Time in the Church's calendar year.

The Sundays and weeks of Ordinary Time lead us through the life of Christ, emphasising his ministry and teachings so that we can mature as his disciples. Thus, we began by returning to the beginning of the public ministry of Jesus and his calling of the first disciples as we reflected on the calling of the Lord and what our proper response should be.

This Sunday continues with that theme of our vocation. But the emphasis this time is on the urgency of obeying God's call. We would hear the message: "Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me" (Mt 10:37). This is, indeed, challenging to many people. The key to accepting it is to trust that, however painful it may be at times, doing God's will always enables us to love the people in our life even more.

Enjoy the journey of 2024 and God's blessings be with you all, Fr Raymond.

Please put your palms in the basket in the foyer as they will be used to provide ashes for Ash Wednesday.




Our Lady of Kāpiti Church App
