Dear Parishioners

As Fr. Raymond is away for a wedding and a short break, here is our reflection this weekend from Fr. Christopher Trummer, a priest who serves as parochial vicar at St. Agnes Parish of the Diocese of Springfield in Illinois.

In the Church today, people rightly demand authenticity from Church leaders as those who represent God and speak on his behalf. People have the right to demand that those who teach about God actually know Him and spend time with Him in prayer, speaking to Him "as a person speaks to a friend." ... a person must really know and love God in order to speak of Him authoritatively'.

In the words of St. Paul, God gives us His treasure in clay vessels (2 Cor 4:7). None of us possesses the full revelation of who God is and what He wills. Our only choice is to humble ourselves and allow God to teach, feed, and protect us through His Church. Only in heaven, when we have finally been prepared to see God, will we no longer need mediators.

And so, in closing, St. Paul reassures us, "We know partially, and we prophesy partially, but when the perfect comes, the partial will pass away" (1 Cor 13:9).



Palms for ashes


Please put your palms in the basket in the foyer as they will be used to provide ashes for Ash Wednesday.
